## Your Activities

**Chute Wood** – Explore Chute Wood, have fun with woodland games such as capture the flag, enjoying a hands on experience seeing and exploring nature.

**Fire Lighting** – Collect your materials for your very own fire, learn how fire works and how important it can be! Can you make your fire last 5 whole minutes?

**Camp Fire/Cooking** – Once your fire is hot enough, cook and enjoy eating some 's'mores'. Does marshmallow and chocolate sound good?

**Shelters** – Build your very own shelter using man-made and natural materials, see and learn the different points used to keep your shelter from blowing away!

**Survival Challenge** – Can your team work together and complete the survival challenge. Will you survive crossing the dangerous swamp and, can you put up your shelter and finally make your fire? Come and find out.

**Tool Work** – Using a variety of tools enjoy making your very own tracking stick, elder tube, marshmallow stick and much more!

**Woodland Crafts** – Enjoy getting hands on with natural materials building and making mini shelters and different crafts while in and around natural spaces.

**Habitats** – Come and see our local habitats that are right on our door step; fox dens, rabbit burrows and much, much more!
